AUTOMOTIVE BODY REPAIRER

<u>GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES</u>: Performs skilled work in removing dents or replacing damaged parts on automotive equipment bodies; does related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Under supervision, an employee in this class performs skilled work in the repair of automotive equipment bodies. General instructions are given regarding jobs to be performed, allowing considerable latitude for planning and implementation of assignments. Work is checked during progress and upon completion by a superior.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative only)

Removes dents in automobiles, truck and construction equipment bodies;

Fills badly dented or rusted out areas with body fill material; sands, files and smoothes to a finished work;

Removes badly damaged parts and replaces with new parts;

Welds breaks in body metal;

Performs minor field servicing of automotive equipment;

Assists in bridge welding;

Maintains electrical and plumbing system of Public Work buildings.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND ABILITIES: Good knowledge of the practices, tools, materials, and terminology used in repair work; good knowledge of the operations of gas and electric arc welding equipment; good knowledge of the occupational hazards and safety precautions of the work; skill in the use of electrical and plumbing repairs; skill in the use of tools associated with automotive body repair work; ability to follow written and oral instructions; ability to lay out and follow through work assignments.

ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience in the repair of automotive bodies.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT for APPOINTMENT: Possession of a valid New York State Motor Vehicle Operator's license.
