TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: The typical work activities listed below, while providing representative examples of the variety of work assignments in the title, do not describe any individual position. Incumbents in this title may perform some or all of the following, as well as other related activities not described.

Assists field personnel in making routine inspections of sanitary conditions of camps, motels, hotels, lodging and boarding houses, bungalow colonies, swimming pools, bathing beaches and food service establishments;

Collects samples from public water supplies and sewage treatment plants;

Maintains surveillance of, and sprays, mosquito breeding sites;

Makes simple field measurements, observations, sketches and diagrams and performs simple calculations in connection with inspections;

Assists in the preparation of reports.
