EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE LEADER

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES: Leads and participates in maintenance of automotive and construction equipment; does related work as required.

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: This is routine work involving responsibility for the servicing of equipment such as mounting plows, stockpiling materials and maintaining the garage. General supervision is received from the Director of Operations with some leeway for planning the specific execution of the assignments.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative only)

Supervises and participates in maintenance of snow plows and related equipment in the quarry;

Uses acetylene torch to cut pipe for, various jobs as required;

Inspects and lubricates equipment;

Changes oil on spreaders;

Cleans and washes trucks;

Mounts snow plows and replaces broken parts;

Cleans the garage;

Stockpiles materials such as pipe, culverts pipe, posts, paint etc.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND ABILITIES: Working knowledge of automotive maintenance and repair methods and of automotive terminology, tools, and safety precautions; demonstrated ability in the operation of a heavy motor truck; ability to understand and follow written and oral instructions; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

ACCEPTABLE EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING: One year of experience as a serviceman in an automotive repair shop; or in the operation or maintenance of construction equipment.

<u>Special Requirement for Appointment</u>: Possession of a valid New York State Motor Vehicle Operator's license.
