PAINT CREW LEADER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is a working supervisory position involving responsibility for leading in and performing a variety of tasks related to the painting of bridges and other highway department structures. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Bridge Supervisor. Direct supervision is exercised over skilled, semi-skilled and unskilled workers assigned to the paint crew. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: The typical work activities listed below, while providing representative examples of the variety of work assignments in the title, do not describe any individual position. Incumbents in this title may perform some or all of the following, as well as other related activities not described.

Leads and participates in a variety of tasks related to the painting of bridges and other structures;

Leads and participates in the repair, painting and erection of standard highway signs and guardrails;

Leads and participates in the painting of highway markers such as railroad warnings and lanes;

Leads and participates in the painting of the interior and exterior of buildings;

Rigs scaffolds and prepares all equipment, tools and materials for use;

Instructs crew members in proper painting procedures, use of equipment and safety precautions;

Reports, verbally, to superiors on the progress or completion of assigned projects;

Transports men and equipment to the work site;

Requisitions supplies, materials and tools;

Assists in a variety of minor maintenance tasks.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL

<u>**CHARACTERISTICS</u>**: Good knowledge of the practices, tools, terminology and accident precautions of the trade; some knowledge of power painting equipment; ability to supervise the work of others; ability to instruct others in the proper procedures and accident precautions of the trade; ability to rig and work from scaffolds; ability to follow simple oral and written instructions; good color perception; manual dexterity; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.</u>
