

## **SENIOR EQUIPMENT PAINTER**

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:** This work involves responsibility for the efficient repair and painting of automotive and construction equipment. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Garage Supervisor. Supervision is exercised over the work of Equipment Painters. Does related work as required.

**TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:** The typical work activities listed below, while providing representative examples of the variety of work assignments in the title do not describe any individual position. Incumbents in this title may perform some or all of the following, as well as other related activities not described.

Supervises and plans the work of Equipment Painters;

Prepares surfaces for painting by applying paint remover, washing, sanding, scraping and taping;

Spray paints highway motor vehicles and equipment;

Touches up damaged paint on highway motor vehicles and equipment;

Performs welding, as needed, on highway vehicles and equipment;

Maintains equipment and makes minor repairs;

May operate steam cleaner;

May assist in maintaining the work area;

May assist in snow removal activities as required.

**FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:** Thorough knowledge of the practices, tools, terminology and accident precautions of automotive repair and painting work; ability to understand and follow simple oral and written instructions; ability to operate power painting equipment; ability to supervise the work of others; good color perception; good motor, hand and eye coordination; manual dexterity; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Two (2) years of full-time paid, or its' part-time equivalent, experience in spray painting and automotive body and fender repair work.

**Special Requirement:** Possession of a valid New York State Driver's license appropriate to the vehicle being operated if assisting in snow removal activities.
